WHEN to Wash Your Hands

- Before, during, and after work
- Before and after eating food
- When moving from one cleaning task or station to another
- After removing gloves
- After touching high traffic areas
 (e.g. handrails, elevators, counters,
 door handles, time clocks)
- After touching your nose, ears, eyes, or mouth
- After using the restroom
- After coughing, sneezing, or blowing your nose
- After taking a work break
- After handling trash or soiled items (e.g. cleaning cloths)
- After using cleaning chemicals
- Whenever they look dirty

HOW to Wash Your Hands



Wet

Wet hands with hot or cold running water.



Wash

Apply soap, lather & scrub backs of hands, under nails & between fingers for 20 seconds. If soap and water are unavailable, use alcohol-based hand sanitizer.



Rinse

Rinse hands under hot or cold running water.



Dry

Dry hands using a clean towel or air-dry.
